- have excellent verbal and written communication skills (or just a love for talking)
- have good IT skills
- be willing to learn about and follow the Citizens Advice aims, principles and policies, including confidentiality and data protection
- be willing to undertake training in your role
- have a positive impact in your community
- good communication skills (or just a love for talking)



How much time do you need to give?

We ask that you can volunteer for at least a minimum of 6 months to 1 year. We can be flexible about the hours that you volunteer so come and talk to us and join us in making a difference whether it's a one cupcake sale, a quiz night, sponsored walk or kind conversation at a time, we'd be thrilled to have you on board.
